Contribution:

The Childminder cares for children ages 0 to 12 years while their parents/caregivers attend programs at Sea to Sky Community Services.

Qualifications:

1. Babysitting or Responsible Adult course.
2. Six (6) months recent related work experience.
3. Or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience.
4. Valid approved first aid certificate.

Job skills and abilities:

1. Basic knowledge of child development and age appropriate activities.
2. Demonstrated ability to provide care and mature guidance to children.
3. Demonstrated ability to work as a contributing member of a team.

Responsibilities:

1. Ensures the child-minding space is set-up and dismantled as required each session.
2. Greets children and parents as they enter the space and introduces oneself.
3. Interacts with children and provides a balance of developmentally appropriate activities.
4. Prepares healthy, appropriate snacks if required by the program. Supervises children while eating.
5. Attends to children's basic needs such as toileting, unless a specific arrangement is made to do otherwise between the parent and childminder staff.

6. Ensures parents/caregivers complete the sign-in and sign-out process and/or maintains records such as attendance as required by the program.
7. Reports problems or concerns to the Program Coordinator or Group Facilitator.
8. Keeps program facilities and equipment safe and clean, reporting any repairs and safety concerns to Program Coordinator or Group Facilitator. Sanitizes toys and equipment as needed.
9. Performs other related duties as required.

Requirements:

1. Criminal Record Review.
2. Signed confidentiality form.
3. Approved reference check.
4. Proof of full vaccination against Covid-19.

Compensation: As per the BCGEU Collective Agreement, the wage is \$22.79 per hour.
