- Completes and maintains related records such as inspection reports, maintenance logs, and incident reports.
- Performs other related duties as required.
- Reports directly to the Facilities Manager.

2. Basic knowledge of HVAC, electrical, and plumbing systems.
3. Two (2) years proven experience in building maintenance; or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience.
