This is a Canada Summer Jobs role. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment term;
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* for the duration of the employment; and,
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
- NOTE: International students are not eligible participants.
