- Connecting clients with stable accommodation.
- Connecting clients with income assistance where appropriate.
- Referring clients to community-based support services.
- Providing support/information to landlords who have housed clients.

Do you have what it takes?

- Diploma in a related human / social service field.
- Two (2) years recent related experience.
- Or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience.
- Knowledge of mental health and addictions issues.
- Knowledge of local community and the services/resources available.
- Valid First Aid Certificate.
- Valid BC Driver's License.
- Own vehicle and ability to travel between Squamish, Whistler, and Pemberton.
- Good organization, time, and general management skills.
- Ability to engage in out of office community outreach.
- Training in non-violent crisis intervention an asset.
- Basic computer skills.

As per the BCGEU Collective Agreement, the starting wage is \$24.48 per hour.
