What does a Homeshare contractor do?

You are responsible for the safety, security, and oversight of the individual in your care. Homeshare contractors are independent contractors supported through the Homeshare program with Sea to Sky Community Services and Community Living BC.

Some of your responsibilities:

- Provide a warm, safe and supportive environment 24 hours per day
- Ensure health needs are met daily
- Ensure monthly and quarterly reporting is completed
- Support individuality, personal choices, and decision making

We are looking for someone who is in **Squamish**.

R is an independent female in her 40's who has lived in Squamish for many years. She loves the community and has many ties to the area including family and friends. She works and travels independently. R is outgoing, friendly and well liked by her peers.

This is an opportunity to make a real difference in the life of a local woman. R requires a positive and patient role model who will support her interests, friendships and assist her in participating in community activities.

This contracted position requires a home study, criminal records check, current first aid certificate and a driver's abstract.
